



CAN YOU OFFER HOUSING FOR REFUGEES?

The network *No One is Illegal* supports people who are forced to live without proper documents in Sweden. We urgently search for apartments and rooms where undocumented migrants can find refuge.

Families, youngsters and adults who are forced to flee their homes and travel the long way to Sweden, get told that they cannot stay here. Instead they are to be deported back to the country they have sacrificed everything to escape. Therefore, some see no other option than to stay in Sweden without a residence permit. They become so-called “undocumented migrants”.

As an undocumented migrant you have almost no rights and have to live with the constant risk of being deported. It is also very hard to find safe housing – can you help out?

THIS IS HOW IT WORKS

1. Register at ingenillegal.org/bostad
2. We'll contact you.
3. We'll match you with someone looking for accommodation.
4. You meet and if everything goes ok, the person moves in.
5. We keep in contact with the both of you.

What sort of housing?

We are mainly looking for apartments or rooms in shared flats for longer periods of time, but everything is of interest. We have matched people with both families, single and collective households, in the city and on the countryside.

What about rent?

Many undocumented migrants have limited possibilities to get money, but in some cases there may be opportunities to raise money for rent. Sometimes there are friends, family or other contacts that can contribute with money.

Is this illegal?

Yes, it's legal to help an undocumented migrant with housing. However, it is difficult to officially rent out an apartment to a person without a social security number.

Are there other ways to help?
